

Recruitment congress for medical residents by NPO Gonryo Association (2012/5/11)


Venue: Gonryo Kaikan (Sendai)

On May 11, hospital congress for recruitment of medical residents was held by NPO Gonrho Association. This congress is held twice a year regularly and aims the increase of medical residents in Tohoku area and related hospitals. Many of the associating hospitals were damaged by Great East Japan Earthquake. It is necessary to accumulate young medical residents who are eager to learn primary care and local public health and good mentors to improve the core hospitals protecting the public health. NPO Gonryo Association also hosts the mentor certification workshop twice a year, mentoring seminars, simulator training course and so on. NPO Gonryo Association publishes Medical Specialist focusing of distinguished mentors of hospitals, guidebook for the teaching hospitals and propagate the activities through website aiming at the improvement of public health.

Prof. Egawa (NPO council) and Prof. Tomita attended the congress. More than a hundred students attended to visit the 45 hospital booth.
